District 68 All Star Managers Information

- 1. Dress Code
 - a. No tank tops or sleeveless shirts
 - b. Must have closed toed shoes; no sandals
 - i. No metal cleats
 - c. Nice shorts or slacks. Jeans are acceptable
- 2. Introduce yourself to the Tournament Director when you arrive at the game site
 - a. Do not bring in outside food for a team picnic anywhere at the game site
 - b. You can arrive at the game site to warm up any time prior to your game time
 - i. The teams involved in the "next" game have priority in the warmup area
 - c. Ask the tournament director for the location of the warmup area
 - d. Players can play catch in a designated warm-up area
 - e. Bats can be used in a safe manner in the designated warm up area
 - Whiffle balls
 - ii. Regular baseballs into a screen
 - iii. Be sure the players are not swinging bats outside the screen area
 - iv. No batting circles or multiple hitters will be allowed
 - v. Tournament Director will determine if "safe"
 - vi. Batting cages are for the host teams only
 - f. Keep you team together and prepare to take the field after your coin toss
- 3. Coin toss 45 minutes prior to game time.
 - a. If you are not there, coin flip will be done without you
 - b. Bring your:
 - i. Affidavit (**no Affidavit, you do not play**)
 - ii. Team Introduction list
 - iii. Filler out Line-up card
 - 1. Need uniform number
 - 2. First initial and last name
 - 3. Starting pitcher and catcher

4. Home Team will be in the 3rd base dugout and Visitors will be in the 1st base dugout

- a. Only the Manger, coaches and players will be allowed on the fields
 - i. No "third Coach"
- Put all bats, helmets and catcher's equipment outside the dugout fence for inspections by the Tournament Director
- c. All bats and helmets removed by the Tournament Director will remain in the Tournament Directors area until after the game is completed
- d. Managers and Coaches will **NOT be wearing gloves** and will not be warming up players
- e. Bull pens will not be used at this time
- f. No bats will be used by players on the field at this time during pregame
 - i. Coaches will be allowed to hit balls to players as long as they only use their half of the field
 - ii. Players cannot use bats at this time
 - iii. No use of the infield....STAY OFF
- 5. **Infield will start 30 minutes prior to game time** (10 minutes each for visitors first followed by the home team).
 - a. The team **NOT taking infield** will have the use of the bull pens (only if one is available)
 - i. If 2 bull pens are available, either teams can use their own bull pen any time during in field warmups.
 - b. A player wearing a catcher's helmet and a catcher's mitt will be catching for the coach hitting infield
 - i. NO COACH WILL BE CATCHING
 - c. A coach may hit to the outfield but only a player wearing a catcher's helmet and a catcher's mitt will be allowed to catch for the coach
- 6. The umpire will call the managers pre-game meeting 10 minutes prior to game time
 - a. All coaches and players will be in the dugout at this time
 - b. Person attending the plate meeting will be the only person allowed to talk with the umpire during the game

7. Introductions

- a. Introductions will be done in order of Uniform Number
 - i. Nick names can be used on the Team Introduction list...Tournament

 Director discretion will be used
 - ii. Have your players and coaches run to home plate, exchange your pins, shake hands and line up behind the foul lines
- b. After the introductions and the pledges, all players will return to the dugouts until the umpire directs to take the field
- 8. During the games, all players, coaches and managers will remain on the field or in the dugouts
 - a. Any player, coach or manager outside this area is subject to ejection
 - b. Good sportsmanship will always be practiced. Any Manager or Coach yelling and humiliating or degrading a player will be subject to ejection.
 - c. No cell phones will be allowed. Electronic scorebooks are allowed.
 - d. All lineup changes will be made directly to the plate umpire
 - i. Be sure to repeat the changes made to the umpire, his lineup card is official
 - e. All pitch count inquiries will be made to the plate umpire
- 9. After the game, be sure to go back to the Tournament Director and pick up your Affidavit, Pitchers Log, a new Team Introduction List and a new lineup card
 - a. Remember, no Affidavit...No next game
